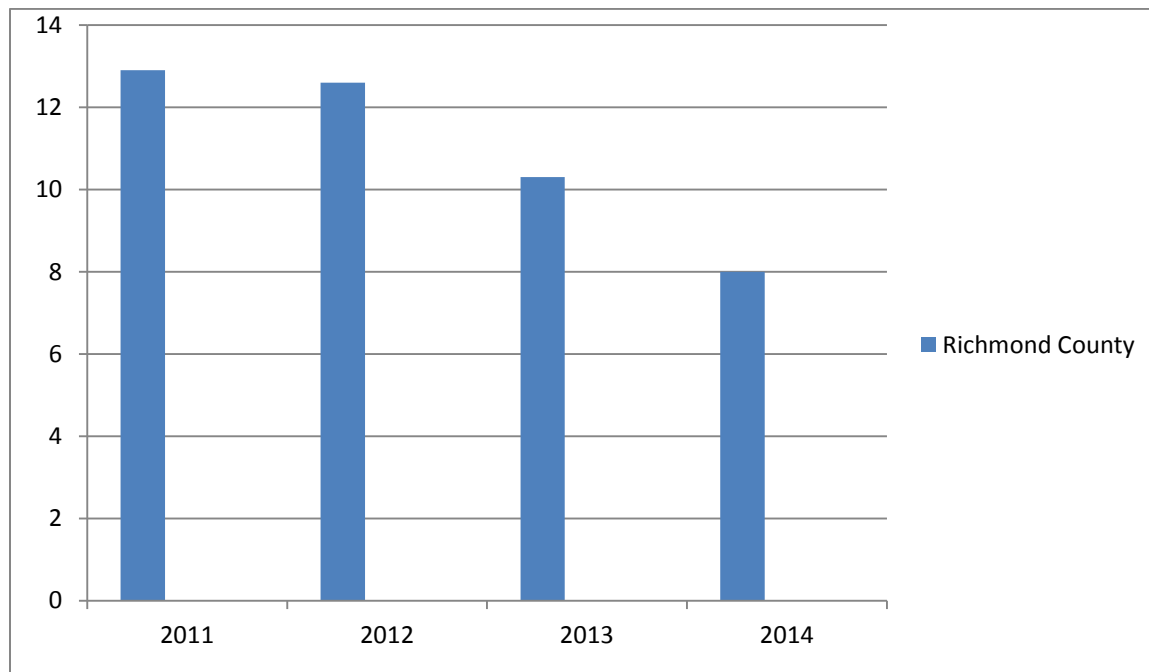

## Yearly Unemployment Rates from the past 4 years

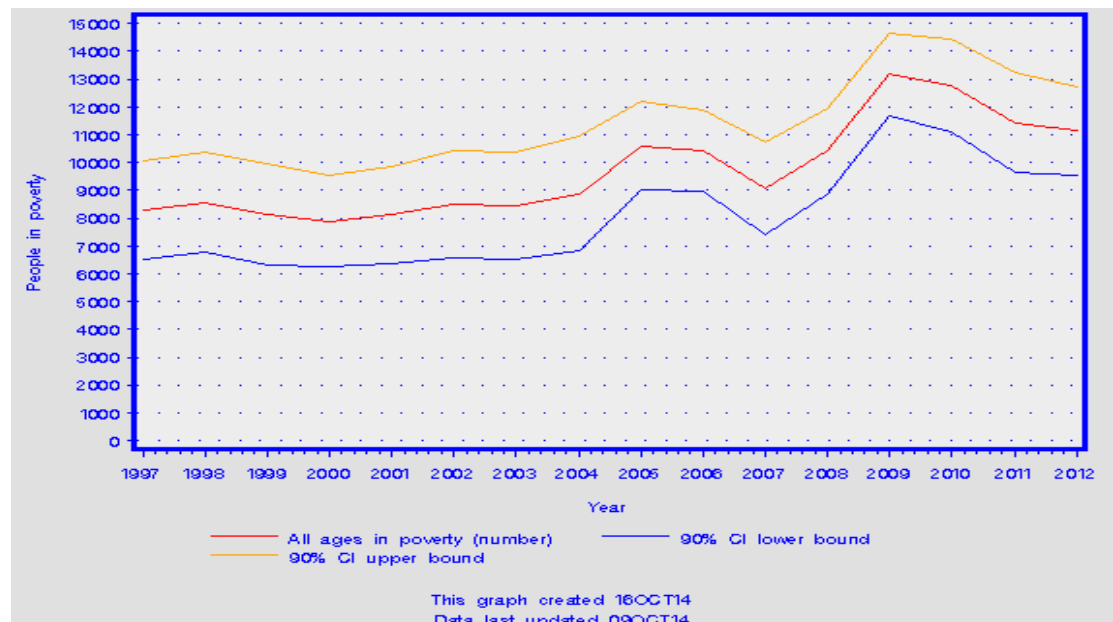


# County Employment Data Continued

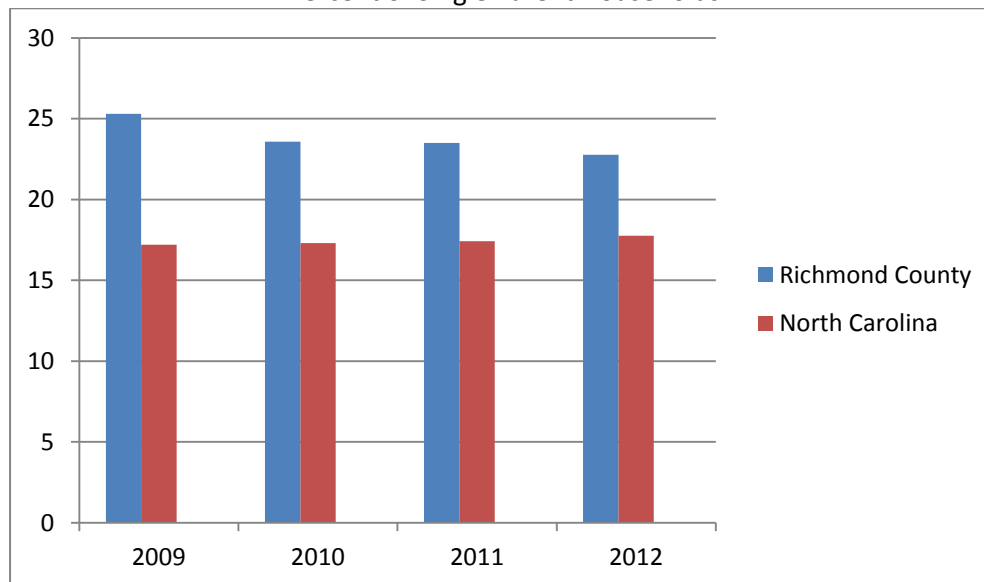

Percent of Single Parent Households



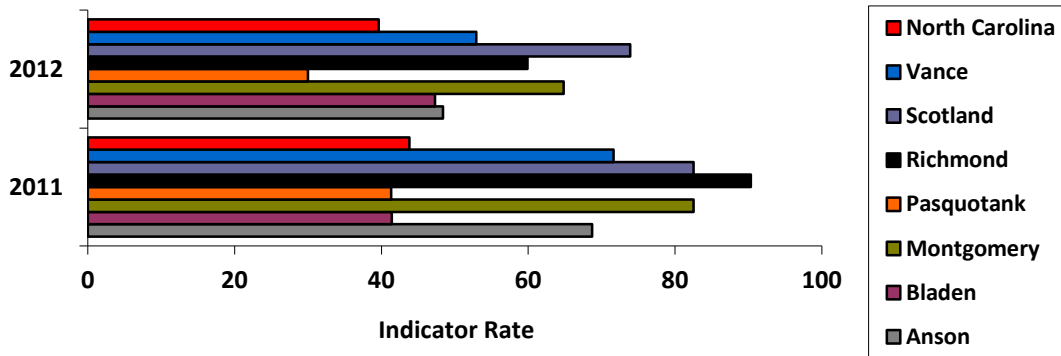

# Manage Care Organization (MCO) DATA

## **Relevant reports related to services needs and gaps for the youth target population ages 6-17**

These are some of the risk factors that have caused the removal of children from the home, most of the fact that I found seem to include the state or they spoke of it nationally. Knowing that all issues are tied together, the health of young people is directly tied to academic achievement and their potential for school success and overall quality of life. The parents nor the school alone cannot solve or prevent out of home placement or health related problem. However, the ability is in the hands of all people to have a positive impact on the children behavior and academic gains are enhanced with the community resources.

### **Some known factors:**

1. Children birth to 36 months of age have been maltreated are at substantial risk of experiencing subsequent developmental problems.
2. Compare to classification at the time of initial contact with DSS, over time a higher proportion of children are described as having fewer risks or with low score on a developmental measure while over time smaller proportion of children are described as having more risks.
3. The educational issues are some of the problem, meaning that children are having a difficult time in school and some of their mental issues are showing in the academics.
4. Ninety percent of student children who had juvenile justice placement during the high school years ultimately are in out of home placement.
5. About seventy percent of children who had substantiated case of abuse or neglect during their school years, with less parental involvement in the education, usually have been at potential risk of being place out of the home.

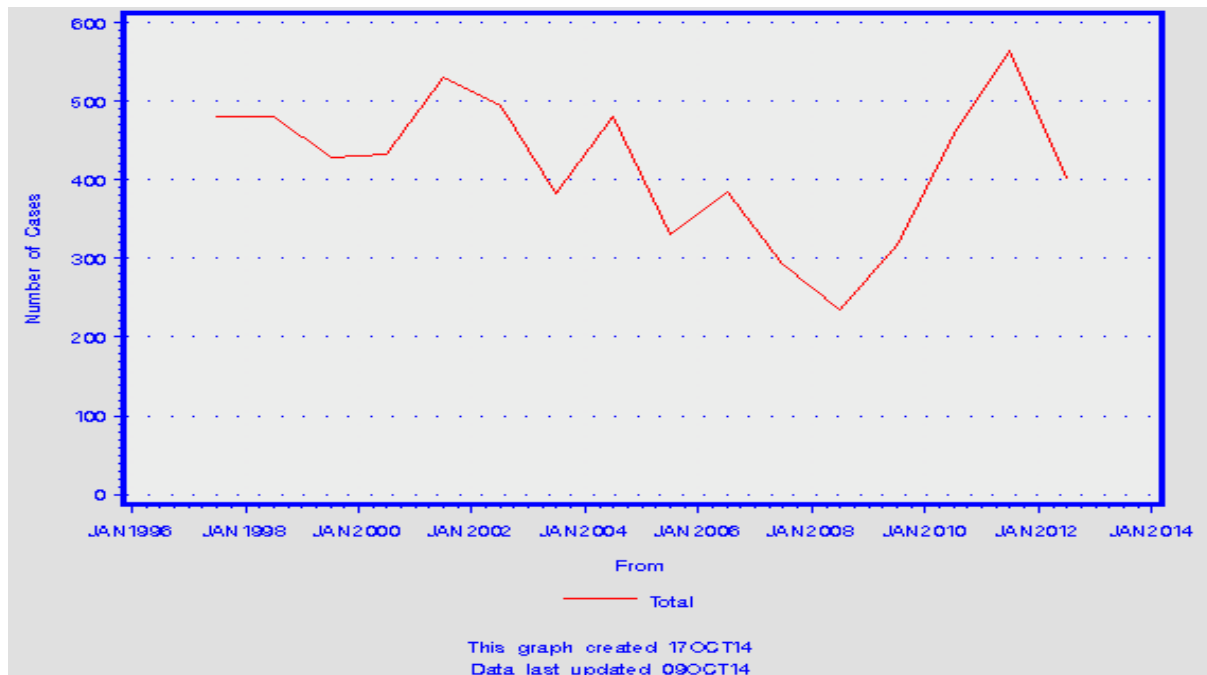

## Number of Children with Investigated Reports of Abuse and Neglect in Richmond County

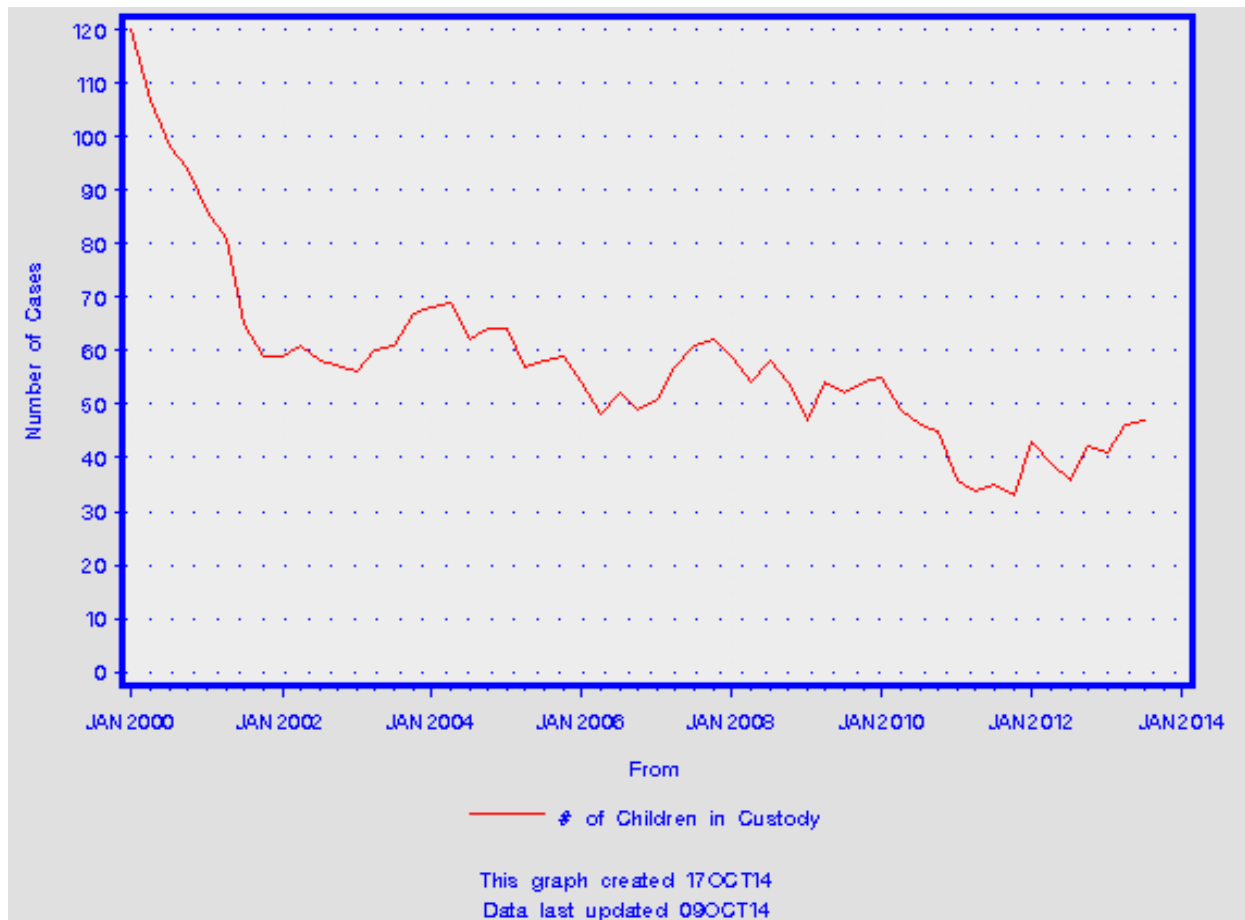
